

Participating in Research: Educational Resources

The Interagency Advisory Panel on Research Ethics (PRE) manages the ethics policy of Canada's research agencies. The policy is called the *Tri-Council Policy Statement: Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans*, or TCPS 2.

PRE has developed a set of educational resources to assist people who are either participating in research or are considering joining a research study. This material offers information about how the ethics guidance in the TCPS 2 provides protection for research participants.
