



Fee Criteria for Industry Sponsored and For-Profit Research

All industry sponsored and for-profit research projects submitted to the health Research Ethics Board (HREB) are subject to a review fee. The invoice for this fee will be sent directly to the contact identified in the HREB application form. Payment is not contingent upon securing approval by the HREB or executing a contract with the Principal Investigator and/or Institution.

The fee applies to:

- Pharmaceutical & medical device companies and agents thereof;
- Research that receives a grant-in-aid from an industry sponsor when the sponsor requests the data back from the researcher;
- Research that involves commercialization or enhancement of commercial and/or profit-making activities;
- Any entity or activity whose goal is to make a profit or have a reasonable expectation of doing so.

The fee is waived for:

- Research receiving a grant-in-aid with no data returned to the sponsor in any form or manner;
- Grant-funded studies from a public, charitable or not-for-profit organization (e.g., CIHR, NIH, 3CTN, Canadian Cancer Society, Heart and Stoke Foundation);
- Research funded by not-for-profit agencies.

(Those funded by multiple sources including a mixture of for-profit and not-for-profit may be subject to a fee)

*Protocol Amendments requiring Full Board review are subject to this fee.

Guidelines for payment:

1. Payment is expected within 30 days of invoice date.
2. Payment should be made in Canadian funds only.
3. The invoice number should be quoted on remittance.
